

Scoring Quick Guide

Step 1: Download the ScoreKeeper app.

IANSEO ScoreKeeper can be downloaded from Google Play (Android) or the Apple AppStore (iPhone or iPad). **Please note:** this is the only step that can be done prior to arriving at your shooting location.

Step 2: Scan Your Unique QR Code

When you are ready to shoot at your host location, you will be provided an official colored scorecard (to return to club) and a white paper scorecard (archer's copy). Please have them available for the following steps. **Please note:** if you late registered, please have a copy of the scorecard provided to you via email.

1. Click the Scan QR button and scan one of the square QR codes located at the bottom of the scorecard (**Day 1 - left side; Day 2 - right side**); please pay attention to the distance (1st or 2nd round/distance = 1st or 2nd day).

What code should you scan? If you registered prior to the early deadline, your QR codes will match on both the colored and white scorecards and you can scan either set. If you late registered, please scan the QR codes on the scorecard provided to you via email and not your colored copy. The late registration colored scorecards contain a generic QR code that will not pull your unique scorecard.

2. When the QR code has successfully been scanned, a grey screen will pull up your competition details.

Double-check that the information matches the scorecard and displays the correct day, then click Save and then Yes to confirm the values.

Step 3: Score Your Arrows

The scoring entry screen will now be displayed.

Information regarding the current end, archer information, and target type is clearly displayed.

The arrow values are entered using the larger colored buttons. You will enter your arrow values end-by-end.

Please note: You will not be inputting inside-out x's on the scoring app. These will be available for tie-break on the physical scorecards only (XO = inside-out x).

The command buttons at the bottom of the screen have functions to show the scorecard view, clear all arrow values, or progress to the next archer (for this specific event, Next Archer means going to the summary and closing the current end).

At this point, you can change scorecard (Edit Scores) or advance to the next end by clicking Continue.

If a single arrow value needs to be changed, that arrow can be selected by clicking on it (will highlight red) and then select the corrected value.

Continue scoring until you have scored all 12 ends. Once your scoring is complete, you can exit the app or select Menu - Setup to return to the setup screen to scan the next QR code and score the next day or another archer.

PLEASE REVIEW! IMPORTANT SCORING REMINDERS:

Values will be written on the scorecard as: XO = inside-out X; X = standard X; 5; 4; 3; 2; 1; M = Miss/O.

Please note: Inside-out x's will be recorded on the paper scorecards only.

Sample scoring ends:

- Each target group, which must consist of at least 3 archers, will score x2 paper scorecards (Official Colored Scorecard + White Scorecard – Archer's Copy). Each individual will be responsible for scoring their own online arrows. Each archer can choose when to do their online scoring, during or after their round. Electronic scores should be inputted by the Monday following your event weekend.
- Colored scorecards should be turned in to the tournament official (at each location) within 30 minutes of the end of the assigned round. **IMPORTANT:** As an added measure, we will ask all archers to take a clear picture of their official colored scorecard prior to turning it in each day. Please store a copy of the photo until January 22, 2021.
- White scorecards should be kept by the archer until the official scores are posted at the conclusion of ALL location dates (approximately January 22, 2021). In the rare occasion that a scorecard is misplaced, it is the archer's responsibility to submit a copy of their scorecard for score verification.
- **ALL SCORING ON THE OFFICIAL COLORED AND WHITE SCORECARDS MUST BE COMPLETED IN INK.** Any changes on the official scorecard must be agreed upon and initialed by all archers in the scoring group. Any archer turning in an incorrect scorecard will be subject to disqualification.
- Electronic scoring will be utilized for all event locations. In the event that data service or a device is not available at the location or for a scoring group, it will be the archer's responsibility to input their scores offsite by the Monday following their event weekend. The electronic scoring will be considered an official form of scoring and failure to comply may result in disqualification of that day's scores. All electronic scores will be unofficial until they are physically verified by headquarters' staff against the Official Colored Scorecard.
